



- Μαρτυρια ... Martyr
- Court witness, testimony.
- Public declaration
- Value of faith worthy of suffering
- Two related words: $K\eta\rho\upsilon\sigma\sigma\omega$ = Preach Euayyellow = Evangelize (120 times in N.T.)

Preach / Evangelize

What was preached?

- -75% = story of Jesus
- -12% = calls to repentance
- -13% = other (Scripture, false gospel, greetings)
- In other words, the central theme of preaching in the Bible is Jesus Christ and His Gospel

Who was preached to?

- The direct object is the message, not the p-ople.
- 60% of the time, the indirect object is a place,
 much of the rest of the time, it is a class of people.
- Implies little or no established relationship with the audience.
- No instance in the entire Bible of "preaching" the gospel to a group of believers!
- Preaching is directed at people who are not Christians = evangelism & missions!

COMMON ELEMENTS:

Μαρτυρια, Κερυγμα, ευανγελιον

- Authority: always comes from God
- Messenger: Usually an apostle or a prophet.
- **Content**: Person & Work of Jesus
- Audience: always non-Christians.
- Response: Repentance and faith
- **Result**: Salvation (freedom from of sin and Satan)
- Effector of Result: always done by God!
- Contrasts: 1) Greek wisdom and 2) Judaism.
- **Parallels**: the Prophets and the Apostles.

Acts Strategy: Scripture



• Gospels: the message to communicate

• Acts: 24x where message is recorded verbatim (25% of the book = sermon templates!)

• Romans: preparation for European initiative (Glasser p. 135)

• Organization of Missionaries



- Is the local church the only organization which should superintend missions?
- Paul's missionary training with Pharisees
- The challenge with my denomination

Acts Strategy - Sodality Biblical Basis



1st SEND-OFF: Acts 13:1-4: at Antioch, in the church ... the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." Then when they had fasted and prayed and laid their hands on them, they sent them away. So, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went ...

2nd SEND-OFF: Acts 15:40 "committed by the brethren to the grace of the Lord"

Acts Strategy: Sodality

Example of Paul's Sodalities:

- Finances (I Thess. 2:9) *"working night and day so as not to be a burden"*
- Authority (I Cor. 14:32) *"spirits of the prophets are subject to prophets"*
- Membership (Acts 15:36-40) self-chosen, not inclusive

• Purpose (Acts 14:21-23)

to plant churches, not to run them



Acts Strategy: Churches

- Goal: Church-Planting (not just evangelism)
- Matt. 16:18 "I will build my church"
- Matt. 28:19-20 "make disciples ... baptizing... teaching all that I commanded"

- Acts 2:38 Peter "repent ... and be baptized"
- Acts 26:15-18 Paul "receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me."

Acts Strategy: Prayer

- Acts 2:42: What did they pray about?
- Jesus' teaching on prayer and mission.
 - Matt. 6:10 "thy kingdom come"
 - Matt 5:44 "pray for them that persecute you"
 - Matt. 9:38 "thrust out laborers"
 - -Mark 13:33 "watch & pray" KJV (cf 2 Pet 3:12ff)
 - -Luke 22:40 "that ye enter not into temptation"
 - -Matt. 17:18-21 Healing/Exorcism

Acts Strategy: Prayer

Paul's prayer guidelines



– I Tim 2: 1-8 "prayers ... be made on behalf of all men, for kings and all who are in authority..." -Col. 4: 2-4 "open a door... proclaim clearly" -2 Thess. 3:1-2 "that the word of the Lord may" run and be glorified... and that we may be delivered from unreasonable and evil men"



Acts Strategy - Suffering

- Mark 10:29 30 "along with persecutions"
- Acts 9:13 16 "how much he (Paul) must suffer for my Name's sake"
- I Thess 3:2 3 "we have been destined for this."
- Col. 1:24 25 "filling up that which is lacking in regard to Christ's afflictions"
- I Peter 4:12-19 "do not be surprised…"



Acts Strategy: Hope

- Col. 1:3-6 "hope laid up for you in heaven..." which has come to you, just as in all the world also it is constantly bearing fruit and increasing"
- I Thess. 4:16-18 "meet the Lord in the air, and thus we shall always be with the Lord, therefore comfort one another with these words."
- I Pet. 1:13 "fix your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus..."

Acts Strategy: Hope

- I John 2:28 "abide in Him so that when He appears we may have confidence..."
- Rev. 7:9 "behold a multitude , from every nation and all tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb..."

We must keep this vision alive. If Paul could saturate Asia in fewer than 30 years, what can the church today do in our lifetime?
